Bury St Edmunds

It's a choice of do as you please for the day in Bury or you can join us at the Greene King Visitor Centre to see how real beer is produced using natural ingredients and traditional brewing methods. The historic working brewhouse has the best view of Bury St Edmunds from the roof (weather permitting). We start at the museum, tour the brewery and then taste the different beers in the Brewery Tap; after the tasting you can visit the shop to purchase gifts, souvenirs and cases of beers.



While you're in Bury why not visit The Nutshell, reputed to be the smallest pub in Britain; and owned by Greene King.

RAF HENDON

Situated on the historic site of London Aerodrome at Hendon, this Museum is the only London attraction to house over 100 aircraft from around the world including some very early aircraft designs through to the latest modern day jets and military aircraft.
